8 Sins of Discord in Galatians 5:19 nkjv

- ▶ Hatred
- ▶ Selfish Ambitions
- ▶ Contentions
- ▶ Dissentions
- ▶ Jealousies
- ▶ Heresies
- ▶ Outbursts of Wrath
- ▶ Envy

- ▶ 1 Peter 3:10 & 11 “Whoever would love life and see good days... must seek peace and pursue it”
- ▶ Mark 9:50 “Have salt among yourselves and be at peace with each other”

- ▶ Romans 5:1 “we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

Making Choices:

- ▶ Proverbs 17:14 “ The beginning of strife is like letting out water, so quit before the quarrel breaks out:
- ▶ James 1:19 “be quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger.”
- ▶ Romans 12:17 we are never to return evil for evil, we are to battle evil with good.

Making Choices

▶ Confronting Difficult Situations

▶ Galatians 6:1 “If a man is overtaken in any trespass you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness...”

▶ Sandwich method

1. Positive feedback
2. Provide constructive criticism
3. End on a positive note

Making Choices

- ▶ Resolving Conflicts
 - ▶ Forgive, it's a decision not an emotion
 - ▶ Ask for Forgiveness
 - ▶ Matthew 5:23-24 if you remember that someone has something against you to be reconciled to them before giving your gift to God
