Stages of Learning

Possible to have students at various levels. Always work to fulfill their needs.

NOVICE: Has a beginning awareness of the Bible & its importance. Often has misconceptions & erroneous ideas regarding the Bible and God. (Visitors and New Converts Children---don't embarrass them for their misunderstanding.)

ADVANCE BEGINNER: Has marginal Bible learning.

(Young children who come often and have a beginning knowledge.)

COMPETENT: Has had good exposure to a number of Biblical subjects. (Regular Attendees of Bible Classes, Worship Services, Home Studies, VBS, etc.)

PROFICIENT: Bible knowledge is internalized and they can apply their

knowledge to a variety of situations. (Consistent Attendee and Begins applying things learned to various situations in their life.)

EXPERT: Life is altered by knowledge learned. Should be the goal of all Bible

students. (What they've learned changes their life!)

The Teaching Process

Stimulate students thinking

You want them to apply what they learn.

Stimulate students desire of inquiry

You want them to ask questions about what they've learned.

Stimulate students to work—HANDS On Approach!!
